

**Participant's Letter of Commitment for Innovative Design Competition of Licensed
Products in 2008 of World Expo 2010 Shanghai, China**

The promisee has been fully aware of and willing to accept Rules of Innovative Design Competition of Licensed Products in 2008 of World Expo 2010 Shanghai, China (hereinafter referred to as "Rules"), and hereby makes the following commitment to the Bureau of Shanghai World Expo Coordination (hereinafter referred to as "Shanghai World Expo Bureau"):

- I) The promisee guarantees the entry he/she has submitted is originated by him/her, which has been not delivered by any means, neither known by the public by any means, except for participating in this competition.
- II) The promisee guarantees that he/she has never applied or develops the entry by himself/herself nor authorized other person to apply or develop the entry globally by any means. Since submission of the entry till announcement of evaluation results of the competition, the promisee will not apply or develop the collected scheme by himself/herself nor authorize other person to apply or develop the entry by any means.
- III) The promisee affirms, in case inventions, utility models or designs which have been patented or applied for patent are used in the entry, the participant will specify true and complete information in the "Description" part of the Registration form and Design Scheme of the Entry, including but not limited to, name or title of the patentee (or patent applicant), name and contact information of the agency issuing the patent certificate (or receiving patent application), patent number and duration, etc.. Disclosed content of the patent or patent application will not participate in this competition.
- IV) The promisee affirms that without written approval of the Shanghai World Expo Bureau, he/she will not deliver, promote or transfer his/her entry or promote his/her participation behavior by any means.
- V) The promisee affirms that upon the receipt of the entry, its intellectual properties (including but not limited to all rights of its plane, three-dimensional or electronic media) will belong to Shanghai World Expo Bureau ab intio, and the Shanghai World Expo Bureau is entitled to conduct any forms of publication, use, modification, development, authorization, permission and protection and other activities. Except for the various potential awards and honors specified in the Rules, the participant will waiver and no longer own any other rights of the entry.
- VI) The promisee agrees that, Shanghai World Expo Bureau and the Office of Innovative Design Competition of Licensed Products in 2008 of World Expo 2010 Shanghai, China (hereinafter referred to as "Competition Office") established under the Shanghai World Expo Bureau are entitled to, as to the extent permitted by law, investigate and verify the information provided or require the promisee to provide additional information within the time limit, for which the promisee shall provide cooperation.
- VII) The promisee guarantees that his/her entry does not infringe legal rights and interests of any third party. In the event of any reputation or economic loss suffered by the Shanghai World Expo Bureau due to infringement of legal rights and interests of the third party by the promisee's entry or other mistakes of the promisee, the Shanghai World Expo Bureau has the right to ask the acceptor to take sufficient and

proper actions to hold the Shanghai World Expo Bureau free from the above mentioned losses. Meanwhile, the Shanghai World Expo Bureau reserves the right to investigate and lodge a claim to the promisee.

- VIII)** The promisee guarantees that his/her commitments are true and reliable, and he/she will kindly implement such commitments. In the event of damage to the Shanghai World Expo Bureau due to violation of such commitments, the promisee will bear corresponding legal responsibilities therefrom. Shanghai World Expo Bureau reserves the right to disqualify the promisee.
- IX)** The Letter of Commitment is governed by laws of the People's Republic of China.
- X)** The Letter of Commitment comes into force immediately after the date of signing (and/or sealing) by the acceptor.
